Meeting called to order by President Taylor

ITEMS FOR DISCUSSION/ACTION:

LAY THE LEVY RATE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018/2019

Commissioner Taylor said the Levy Rate for this year will remain the same as last year at 14.07 per hundred for Class I property, 28.14 per hundred for Class II property, 56.28 per hundred for Class III property and 56.28 per hundred for Class IV property.

The taxes levied that they anticipate bringing in is 5.8 million dollars, less delinquencies, exonerations and the 2% for the valuation fund that they give the Assessor as per State Code of 108,000.00. So the net amount to be raised by levy of property taxes for budget purposes is 5.2 million dollars for the next fiscal year based on the Levy Rate of 14.07.

Commissioner Scott said he was very pleased that they did not have to raise the Levy Rate as they were able to pass a responsible budget and that did not cause them to have to raise the Levy Rate and the budget increased by about 1%.

Commissioner Scott moved to approve the Levy Rates as presented.
